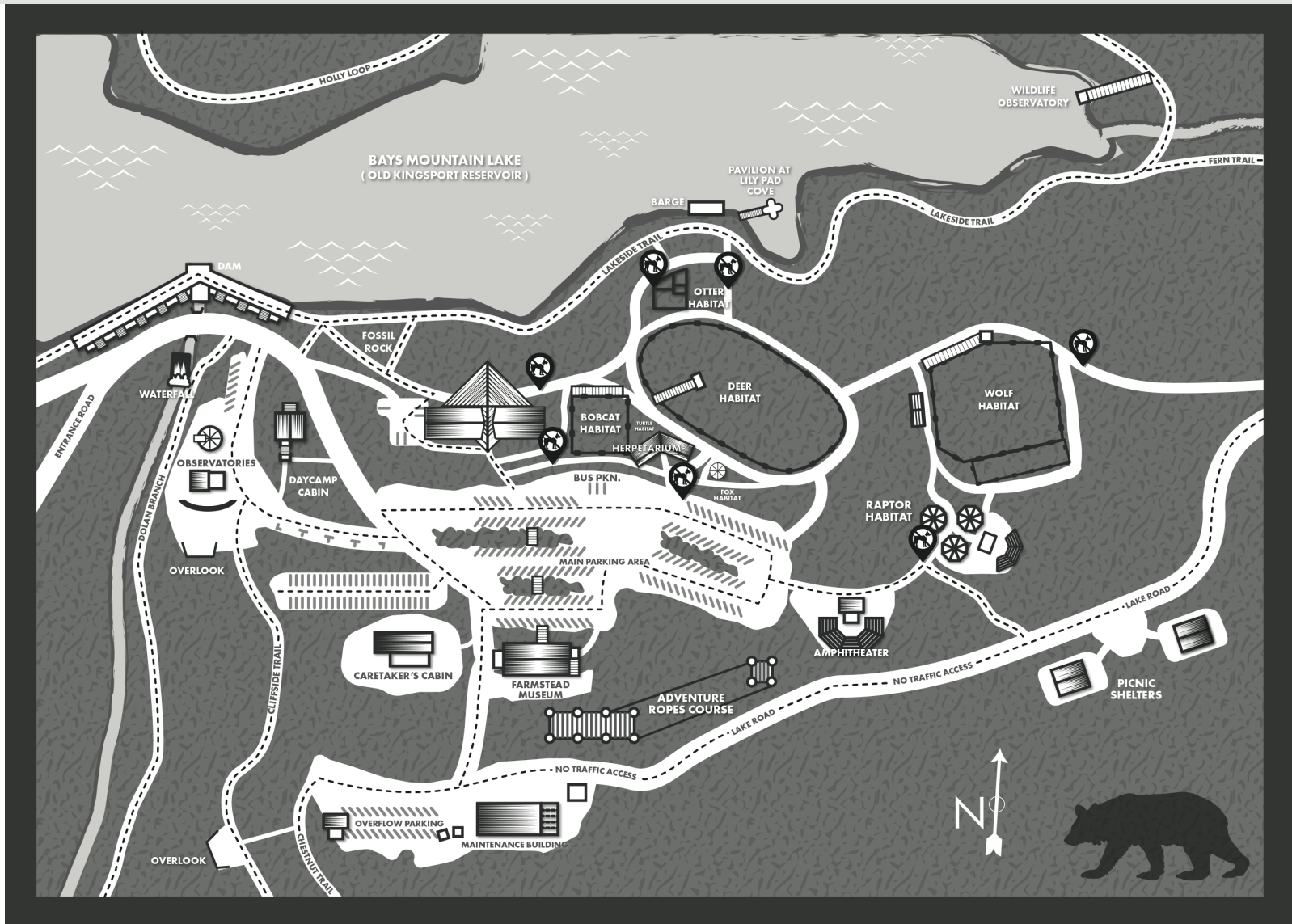


Bays Mountain Dog Trail Map











To ensure our animal's safety please stay free from habitat areas. On the map above please follow designated trails with a dotted line that are suitable for pets.

Bays Mountain Park's Dog Policy



Bays Mountain Park is a designated natural area where wildlife are free to roam undisturbed. Park visitors should be able to enjoy native wildlife in their natural environment without the disruption of pets. If you consider bringing a pet to the park, the following rules must be followed to ensure a great experience is had by all visitors to Bays Mountain Park:

-  Dogs/Pets ARE NOT allowed in the animal habitat area. Signs are posted for your convenience.
-  All dogs/pets MUST be kept under physical control at all times on a physical lead/leash not exceeding six feet in length.
-  Dogs/Pets are not allowed to run freely.
-  Please be considerate and clean up your dog feces.
-  DO NOT leave your pet unattended or tied to an object.
-  DO NOT leave your pet unattended in your vehicle. Police/animal control authorities will be notified.
-  Bays Mountain Park is not responsible for any exchange of disease between pet and wildlife.
-  There is a possibility that your pet could become prey for a bear, coyote, owl or other predator.
